ORAL ORDER

4 21-08-2015 Heard Sri Gajendra Kumar Jha, learned counsel, who was assisted by Sri Sushil Kumar Jha, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned AC to SC-17.

The petitioner, who was initially engaged as daily-wager on 30.09.1989 and on adhoc arrangement, he was appointed on 29.12.1989 and finally his service in adhoc arrangement came to an end on 13.07.1990, has approached this Court invoking its writ jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to direct the Respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for regularization of his service. It has been admitted that after 13.07.1990, the petitioner is not in job.

In view of the fact that adhoc arrangement of work in respect of the petitioner had come to an end long back on 13.07.1990 and the fact that regularization is not a mode of appointment, the writ petition stands dismissed.
