Nobody appears on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State and the respondent-Gaya Municipal Corporation are present.

From the counter affidavit and supplementary counter affidavit filed on behalf of the respondent-Corporation, it appears that all admitted dues of the late-husband of the petitioner have already been paid though during the pendency of the writ application and further that the petitioner has been given employment on compassionate ground.
