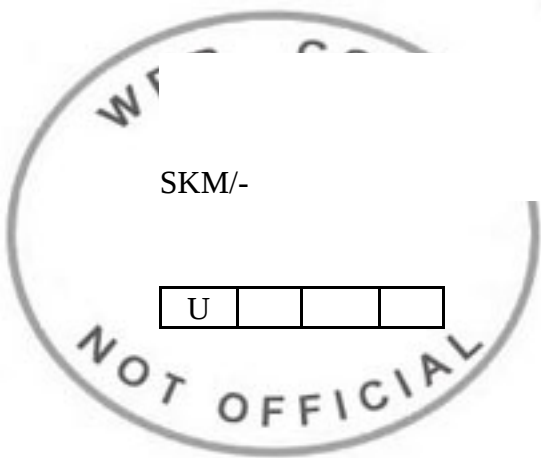
ORAL JUDGMENT
