Heard the parties.

The present writ petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner seeking a direction to the appellate authority for disposing of the Mutation Appeal Case No. 51 of 2010-11 filed on behalf of the petitioner against the order passed by the original authority regarding mutation of the lands in question.
