**ORAL ORDER**

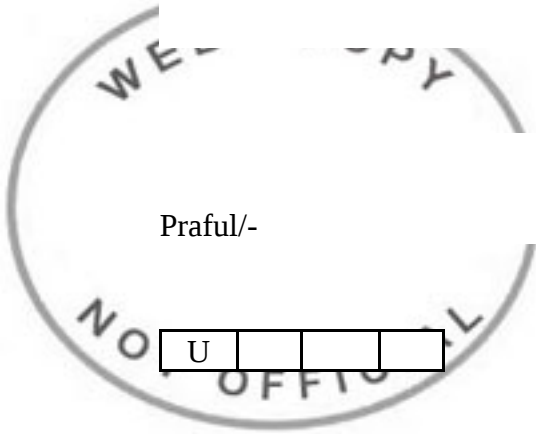
2      07-08-2015                      After some argument, Sri Vinay Mistry, learned
