GA-13 for the State.

2. The present application has been filed for modification of
the order dated 17.08.2009 passed in C.W.J.C. No.9695 of 2009,
which was disposed of with the following observations/directions:

“In the above circumstances, the learned counsel for the
petitioner submits that for expeditious disposal of the pending claims
as raised in this writ application, the petitioner proposes to file a fresh
representation before the District Magistrate, Madhepura (respondent
no.3). In case such a representation is filed stating the details of the

claims as also enclosing the copy of the relevant documents in support of his claims along with the certified copy of the present order within a period of four weeks, the respondent no.3 shall consider the grievances of the petitioner as raised in his representation and dispose it of in accordance with law expeditiously, preferably within a period of four months on receipt of such representation, so that the admitted retiral dues could be paid to the petitioner without further delay.”

3. I find no reason to modify the order dated 17.08.2009 passed in C.W.J.C. No.9695 of 2009. Accordingly, this application stands dismissed.
