The Petitioner seeks quashing of the order dated 23.12.2006 passed by the Judicial Magistrate, Begusarai in Complaint case No.137C of 2001 and the order dated 20.8.2007 passed by the F.T.C. IInd, Begusarai in Criminal Revision No.50 of 2007, by which they have refused to summon the Opposite Party No.8 to face trial under the provisions of Section 319 Cr.P.C.

Having gone through the impugned order, I find that it was for good reason that such a prayer was disallowed.

Hence, finding no merit in the application, the same is

dismissed.

The Trial Court is directed to conclude the trial positively within a period of thirty working days without granting unnecessary adjournments to any party.
