If across the board the category to which the petitioner belongs has been granted benefit of revised pay-scale from 1.1.1996 of Rs.5000-8000/-, no special indulgence can be shown to the petitioner by giving the benefit of pay-scale of Rs.5500-9000.

The decision to extend such a benefit emerges from the details which have been urged in the counter affidavit, filed on behalf of the State, especially para 7 onwards.

In view of the above, there cannot be any order for providing other replacement scale of either Rs.5000-8000/- or Rs.5500-9000/- as is the prayer made in the writ application.

Since there has to be some kind of policy amongst the

employees, decision of the State seems to be rationale and cogent.

Writ has no merit. It is dismissed.
