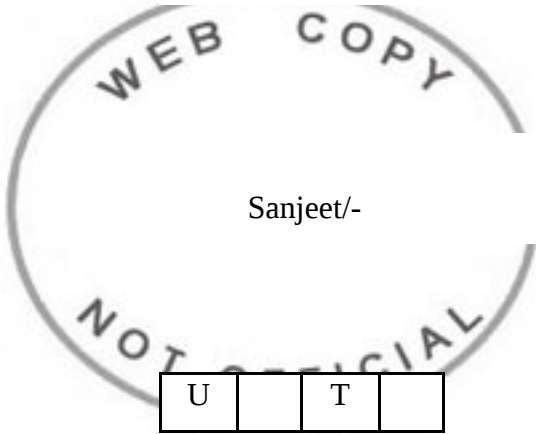
The petitioner is neither an informant nor an accused in Meenapur P.S. Case No.209 of 2010.
