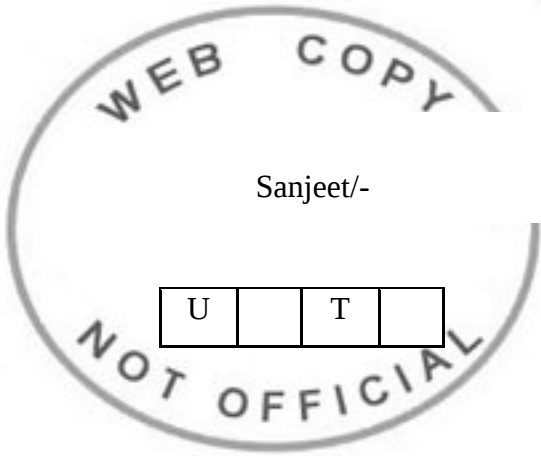
ORAL ORDER
