ORAL ORDER

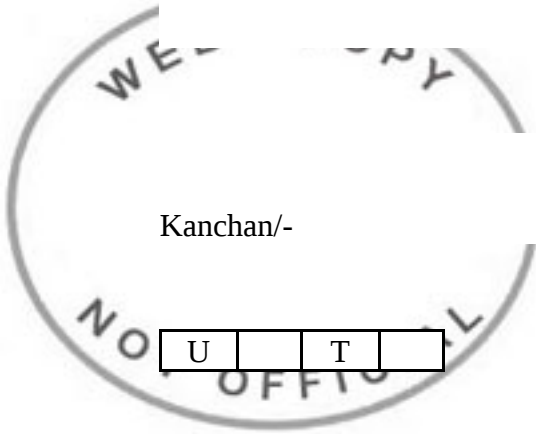
3 03-12-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
