Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Having regard to the fact that the payment, as directed
by this Court in the connected writ application, has been made, the
grievance of the petitioner that full payment has however been not
made, could have made sense had this Court had also quantified
such amount. This Court had however never quantified the amount
and therefore, there will be hardly any occasion for this Court to
continue with this contempt application.

That being so, this contempt application, on account of
the stand taken by the opposite parties with regard to payment

made to the petitioner to the extent it was admissible and payable, must be deemed to have become infructuous and is accordingly disposed of.

Nothing said in this order, however, will come in the way of the petitioner in pursuing his claim of balance payment, if any in accordance with law.
