He has further submitted that the process was also to be completed soon.

Having regard to the aforementioned stand this Court would only direct that if the consequential action as per the aforementioned policy decision has not been taken as yet, the

same must be taken within a period of one month from the date of receipt of this order and if the petitioner is found entitled to any payment that, if not paid by-now, must be paid to him within a period of two months from the date of receipt of this order.

With the aforementioned direction, this contempt application is disposed of.
