3 13-01-2015 The petitioner has filed the present writ petition seeking a direction to the respondents to promote him on the post of Assistant Sub-Inspector of Excise w.e.f. 27.10.2004.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that the persons junior to the petitioner have been granted promotion to the higher post, yet the claim of the petitioner has not been considered and decided. However, in response to the query made by this Court he has fairly conceded

that the petitioner has now superannuated from service on 30.06.2012 from the post of Constable.

In above view of the matter, this Court is not inclined to exercise its discretionary powers for granting the relief as prayed for on behalf of the petitioner, since at this belated stage, it would not be expedient to unsettle the seniority, which has attained its finality. Accordingly, the writ petition stands dismissed.
