Learned AAG has rightly pointed out that no
wrong has been committed to the petitioner. He is questioning the
appointment of some other persons as constables. Referring to

getting employment on manipulated date of birth was the subject
matter of the departmental proceeding initiated against the

respondent no.8 wherein he has been exonerated.
