ORAL ORDER

3 30-09-2015 After some argument, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners, in presence of the learned State counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents no. 1 to 9, seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition with a liberty to approach the learned Bihar Land Tribunal, Patna for grant of appropriate relief(s) with respect to the lands under dispute, as also with respect to the order impugned in the present proceeding.

Permission is accorded.

The writ petition stands disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid. I.A. No. 5522 of 2012 stands disposed of accordingly.

The parties shall be at liberty to raise all the issues of facts and law before the learned Bihar Land Tribunal, Patna, which may be available to them.

If an appropriate petition is filed on behalf of the petitioners before the learned Bihar Land Tribunal, Patna within a period of two months from today with a certified copy of the present order, and if it is found that it has become barred by limitation and if any petition is filed on behalf of the petitioner for condonation of such delay, then the learned Bihar Land Tribunal, Patna shall take into consideration that on a bonafide legal advice, the present writ petition was filed before this Court on 09.08.2012 and that remained pending till date.
