Heard Sri Anil Kumar Saxena, learned counsel for petitioners, learned A.C. to Govt. Pleader – 11 as well as Sri Surendra Kumar Singh, learned senior counsel, who was assisted by Sri Praveen Prakash, learned counsel for respondent no. 4 & 5.

In the present writ petition, an order passed by the Joint Director, Consolidation, Gaya under Section 35 of the Bihar Consolidation of Holdings and Prevention of Fragmentation Act, 1956 is under-challenge, which is a schedule Act under Section 9 of the Bihar Land Tribunal Act, 2009. The Court considers that this matter can well be adjudicated by the Tribunal.
