Heard the parties.

In view of show cause filed on behalf of the opposite party nos. 1 and 2 showing therein that in compliance of the order dated 06.08.2014 passed in CWJC No. 12836 of 2014 (Annexure-1) a reasoned order dated 12.02.2015 (Annexure-A to the show cause) has been passed by the Secretary of the Road Construction Department, Government of Bihar, Patna, this Court is satisfied that no further action is required to be taken against the opposite parties in the present proceeding.

The present MJC application stands disposed of as it has become infructuous.
