The present petition was filed with a prayer to initiate
contempt proceeding against opposite parties on an allegation of
wilful disobedience to an order dated 13-10-2011 passed in
C.W.J.C. No. 17929 of 2011, whereby, this Court had directed the
respondents to clear all the retiral dues of the petitioner within
specified time. Subsequently, on an allegation of non-compliance

of the order of the writ court, the present petition was filed for initiating contempt proceeding.
