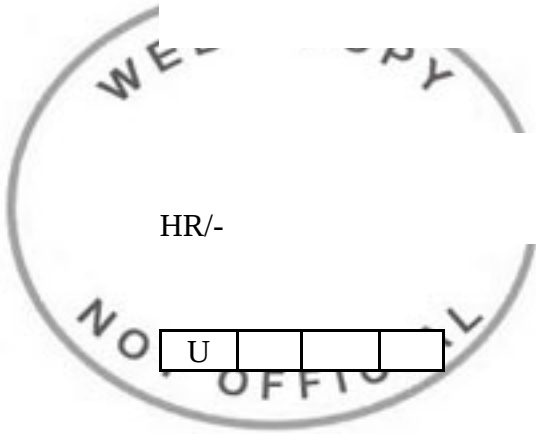
4 24-06-2015 Heard Mr. Ratan Kumar for the petitioner and counsel
