the suspension order stands stayed.

The controversy behind the suspension of the petitioner is
not required to be gone into especially when law has been set in
motion in this regard. The appropriate authority will deal with the
petitioner.

In view of the above, let the petitioner continue on his post
due to stay of the suspension order till any other decision adverse to

his interest is taken by the competent authority.

If there are dues of subsistence allowance and salary rightfully, petitioner will make a claim. The authority has an obligation to settle it within a period of three months thereof.

Writ application is disposed of with observation as above.
