I.A. No. 5706 of 2015 has been filed by the appellant, under Section 5 of the Limitation Act, seeking condonation of delay of 1 year and 124 days in preferring the present appeal against the order, dated 06.08.2012, passed by the learned single Judge in CWJC No. 6131 of 2005.

Heard Mr. Pramod Kumar Verma, learned Counsel, appearing on behalf of the appellant, and Mr. Ajeet Kumar, learned Counsel, appearing on behalf of the respondents.

Having considered the reasons assigned in the present petition seeking condonation of delay and having heard the learned

counsel for the parties, this Court is satisfied that the appellant was prevented by sufficient causes from preferring the appeal within time.

In view of the above, the delay of 1 year and 124 days, in preferring the letters patent appeal, is hereby condoned.
