29.10.2015 Having heard counsel for the petitioner and counsel for the State and examined the materials and pleadings on record, the petitioner is given liberty to satisfy the respondent-authorities with regard to the utilization of the advance taken by him for the period in question.

Since it is a matter of accounting, which could not be done for whatever reasons and controversies, this Court will not give clean chit to the petitioner or waive endorsement made against his LPC. Matter will have to be resolved between the petitioner and the Department

concerned, because it involves public money.

A decision in this regard must be taken, if the petitioner renders assistance, preferably within a period of six months from the date of production / communication of a copy of this order.

Writ application stands disposed off, accordingly.
