ORAL JUDGMENT

The petitioner is aggrieved by the interim order dated 07.08.2014. The remedy or forum for him getting it vacated for expediting adjudication of the matter will be the same forum.

This Court will not exercise its discretion in a matter like this by entertaining the writ application at this juncture. Let the petitioner move the authority by an appropriate application or petition which will be heard and decided in accordance with law by the said authority. The authority is directed either to hear the application of the petitioner on the interim stay granted or decide the appeal. All this

must be done within a period of three months since it is a 2014 appeal.

Writ application is disposed of with the above direction.
