Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioners and learned AC to SC-29, appearing on behalf of the State.

2. This contempt application has been filed asserting the

non compliance of the order dated 07.12.2010 passed in C.W.J.C. No.5909 of 2010.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that the order under contempt has already been complied with by the opposite party nos.3 and 4, respectively, the member Secretary, National Council for Teacher Education, Hans Bhawan, Wing-II, Bahadurshah Zafar Marg, New Delhi and the Regional Director, Eastern Regional Committee, National Council for Teacher Education, 15 Neelkanth Nagar, Nayapalli, Bhubaneswar, Orissa vide order dated 03.03.2015 and, as such, he does not want to proceed with the case further.
