2 07-12-2015 Considering the prayer made in this writ application, in my view, the writ application appears to have become infructuous.

The petitioner is the husband of the respondent No.2 . In a proceeding instituted by the respondent No.2/wife under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, the Court granted maintenance pendente lite at the rate of 10,000/- (Rs. 5,000/- for herself and Rs. 5000/- for her son). A sum of Rs. 15,000/- (fifteen thousand) was also directed to be paid to her as a lump sum amount towards litigation cost. The petitioner has prayed for a direction for quick disposal of the said case.

No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

This prima facie indicates that the petitioner has lost interest in pursuing the present writ petition.

The writ application is dismissed.
