By way of filing the present writ application under
Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has
made the following prayer in paragraph no. 1 of the writ petition:-

“1. That this application is being filed for issuance
of an appropriate writ/writs, direction/directions to
the respondent authorities, prohibiting them from
misusing the provisions made in Code of Criminal
Procedure Code as any action under Sections 107,

144, 145 etc. frequently in connivance of private respondent no. 5 upon the lands bearing Khata No. 17, Khesra No. 382, Area-3-0-2 for which civil suit, Probate case as well as the case in Bihar Land Tribunal are pending between the parties.”

Regard being had to the prayer made as quoted hereinabove, I am of the view that the application is thoroughly misconceived. It is dismissed, accordingly.
