Contemnor opposite party through Sri
Fakhruddin Ali Ahmad, A.C. to S.C.-3 has produced
order dated 21.07.2015 passed by the Division
Bench in L.P.A. No. 485 of 2012, whereunder
contemnor opposite party has been allowed two
month' further time from the date of the order i.e.
21.07.2015 to pass fresh order taking into account
the purport of the scheme of A.C.P. as well as the

nature of appointment of the first respondent. It is submitted that the contemnor opposite party shall avail the opportunity allowed by the Division Bench and shall pass appropriate order within the time granted by the Division Bench.

2. In view of the statement made by the counsel at the Bar, I dispose of the contempt application trusting the contemnor opposite party that he shall abide by his undertaking to pass appropriate order in the matter within the time aforesaid.
