Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

If what is alleged by the petitioner is correct then this is a case of gross negligence by the respondent authorities as an application filed for grant of licence for DBBL gun in the year 1999 had remained pending till date though the petitioner has stated that Officer Incharge of the concerned Police Station vide Annexure 2 has made a recommendation for transfer of licence of the father of the petitioner in his name in the year 2001 itself.

However, this writ application is being disposed of with a direction to the licensing authority concerned to take a

decision on the application of the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt / production of a copy of this order if the same has not already taken.
