submitted that the valuation of the first appeal is, Rs.1,396.50 in

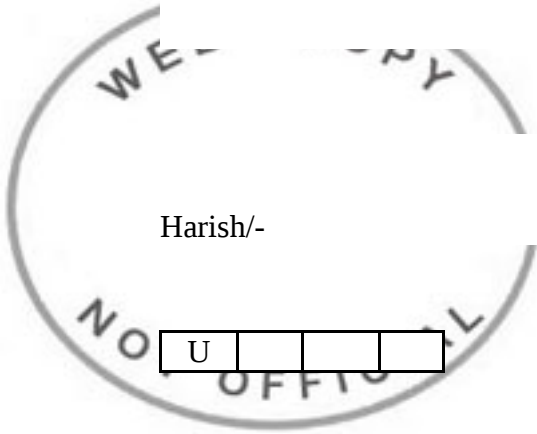
excess of valuation of Rs.3 lacs. Therefore, in view of the said
