If the petitioners do not have the requisite qualification and degree, which is duly recognized by any authority much less the authorities of the Education Department of the State of Bihar, the decision of the Tribunal to annul their appointments is not required to be interfered with because they have some kind of degree from what is known as Bhartiya Shiksha Parishad, Lucknow, which is not even shown as one of the institution by the Council of Boards of School Education in India or any recognition by NCTE,

Writ is dismissed.
