The petitioner is a P.D.S. dealer. He is aggrieved by
order dated 10.10.2011 passed by Sub-Divisional Officer,
Samastipur, by which his P.D.S. license has been cancelled.

The petitioner submits that his P.D.S. license has
been cancelled on the very flimsy ground.

However, I find that the petitioner has preferred an
appeal bearing Appeal Case No. 73 of 2011 against the order of
cancellation of his P.D.S. license.

As the appeal is of the year 2011, I direct the
Collector, Samastipur to dispose of the same within a period of

six weeks from the date of receipt / production of a copy of this order.
