ORAL ORDER

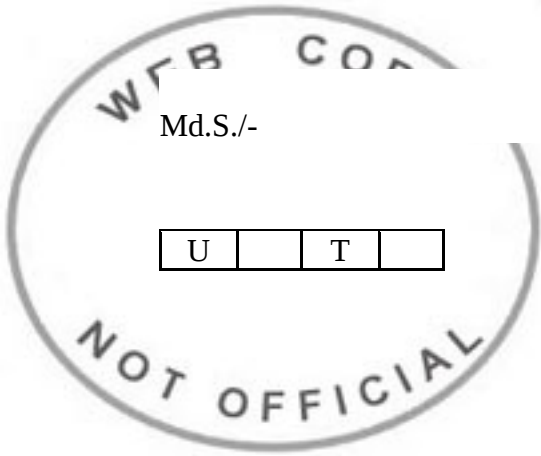
2 05-01-2015 Heard Mr. Rajendra Kumar Jain, learned counsel for the
