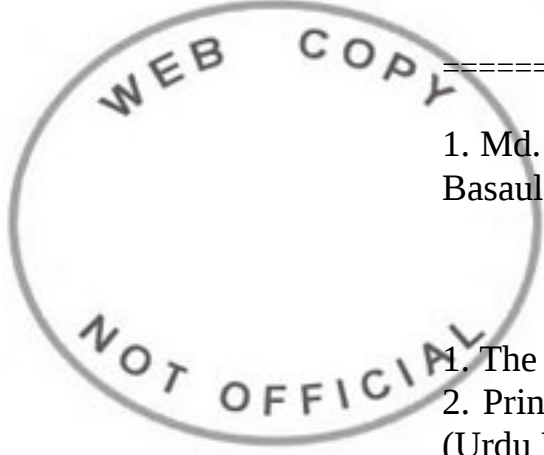

ORAL ORDER

4 08-05-2015 The petitioner makes a grievance that his salary has not been paid from December 2006 to February 2007, and further after November 2012, till date. He also wants for a direction upon the respondents to ensure payment of this claim within a reasonable time frame.

The petitioner has a long chequered service career. Whatever things attributable to him, if there are periods of non-

payment or discrepancy emerging in his L.P.C., where fraud and interpolation has been alleged, then obviously the salary payment cannot be made smoothly and regularly.

Be that as it may, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction upon the District Magistrate, Banka that taking cognizance of letter No. 64 dated 17-2-2014(Annexure-H to the counter-affidavit), he shall take a decision and issue appropriate direction with regard to the above mentioned prayer within three months from the date of production of a copy of this order. The time fixed above must be adhered to by the District Magistrate.
