ORAL ORDER

4. 17-08-2015 At the very outset, an objection was raised by learned A.C. to Addl. Advocate General - 3 that against the order impugned, the petitioner was having statutory remedy to approach the civil court instead of approaching this Court invoking its writ jurisdiction.
