If the petitioner has been able to remove the inadequacy, which had gone into the decision making for rejection of claim for recognition by the State of Bihar, the petitioner is free to move the competent authority with all supporting materials and the authority will depute a reasonable, honest and upright officer to verify the authenticity and correctness thereof. The Court has used certain adjectives deliberately for a reason, which is not required to be

expanded and explained.

Writ application is disposed of with the above observation and direction to take decision within reasonable time frame.
