Till the identity of the school of the petitioner is established and becomes undisputed by the competent authority, this Court is not willing to give a direction that the fund released by the State Government in terms of Annexure- 1, is required to be chanalized into the hands of the present petitioner.

The petitioner may either file a suit for declaration or move

the competent authority for appropriate decision in this regard. No relief can be granted in favour of the petitioner to the extent as prayed for in this writ application at this juncture.

The writ application is accordingly dismissed.
