ORAL ORDER

5 12-10-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

This Court, vide order dated 21st April 2011 passed in
CWJC No. 9603 of 2010, found the impugned order was not
sustainable, set aside the same, but with a liberty to the Authority
to pass a fresh order.

In pursuance of the direction, the Authority/opposite
party considered the case of the petitioner and disposed of the
same by passing the order of punishment against the petitioner
vide order dated 21st March 2013 (Annexure-3 to the show cause).

The counsel for the petitioner submits that the order

has been passed altogether on new charges, apart from the charge which was subject matter of earlier proceeding.

This Court cannot enlarge the scope of a contempt proceeding and convert the same in the writ application.

The petitioner, if so advised, may challenge the impugned orders in a properly constituted proceeding before the appropriate Court/Forum/Authority.

Accordingly, this application is disposed of.
