Contempt petitioner was respondent no. 4 in C.W.J.C. No. 4356 of 2012 which was filed by Jai Shankar Singh and his wife as petitioner nos. 1, 2 assailing the order bearing Memo No. 1189 dated 30.12.2010, passed by Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Bettiah Sadar. This Court disposed of the said writ petition asking Jai Shankar Singh and his wife to seek review of the order dated 30.12.2010 before the Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Bettiah Sadar, who was the

author of the said order. In the light of the direction of this Court contained in order dated 12.10.2012 Jai Shankar Singh and his wife filed Case No. 88M/2011 (Misc.) before the Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Bettiah Sadar, who vide order dated 14.02.2014 cancelled the order dated 30.12.2010. In the circumstances, if petitioner, who was respondent no. 4 in C.W.J.C. No. 4356 of 2012, and opposite party in Case No. 88M/2011 (Misc.) is aggrieved by the order dated 14.02.2014 she should challenge the said order in accordance with law.

With the observation aforesaid, the contempt petition is disposed of.
