It is evident from reading of Annexure- 3 that the petitioner was not holding the post of Assistant Settlement Officer in a substantive capacity. He was only officiating on the post. The transfer has been effected on administrative considerations and it seems to be general transfer effected by the respondents, that too on 30th of June, 2015.

In view of the same, no interference is warranted with the impugned order contained in Annexure- 3. Writ is dismissed.
