**ORAL ORDER**

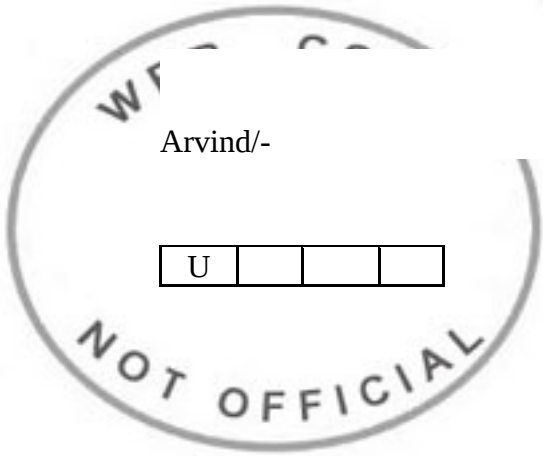
