ORAL JUDGMENT

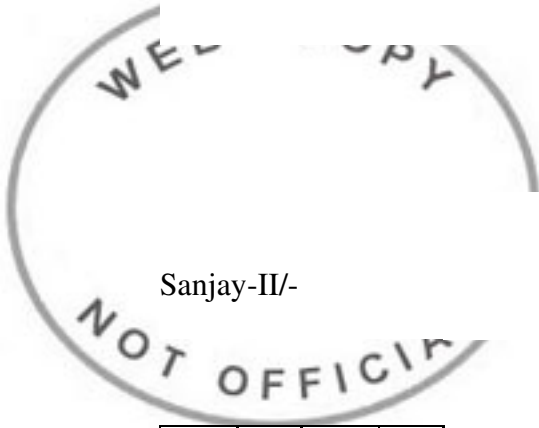
