It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that victim went missing on 12.01.2014 and thereafter the petitioner was searching her and ultimately he was arrested on 18.02.2014. The identity of the victim has not been made and only on suspicion it is claimed that victim was the wife of the petitioner.

Considering the fact that petitioner took no initiative to lodge any case when his wife went missing, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner at present. However, petitioner will be at liberty to renew his prayer for bail, if the trial will not be concluded within a period of one year. It is expected from learned Court below to expedite the trial.

Accordingly the application is dismissed in connection with Sessions Trial No. 424 of 2014, arising out of Ghora-Sahan P.S. Case No. 19 of 2014.
