This is an application, made under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, seeking bail by the petitioner, namely, Neeraj Kumar, in connection with Mahendiya Police Station Case No.17 of 2014, under Section 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Perused the above application and materials on record.
