ORAL ORDER

2 27-01-2015 The petitioner is being tried for offence punishable

under Section 498-A and other allied sections of the Indian Penal

Code. The petitioner has surrendered and is in prison since

19.5.2014.

The petitioner filed Bail Petition No.211 of 2014/1245
of 2014 in the court of Ad hoc A.D.J.-IInd, Gaya and the same
was dismissed on 26.8.2014. Hence, this application.

The allegations against the petitioner are only referable
to Section 498-A, I.P.C. In the recent past Hon'ble Supreme Court
held that arrest and continued detention, in cases registered under
Section 498-A, I.P.C. is almost unwarranted. Therefore, further
detention of the petitioner is not at all warranted.

Hence, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Smt. Pratibha Singh, Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class at Gaya, in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No.11 of 2014.
