Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the  
State.

The Petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for  
the offences under Sections 7, 13(2) r/w Section 13(1)(d)  
of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.

Considering that the Petitioner is in custody  
since 23.08.2014 and the entire case is based on  
documentary evidence which has already been collected  
as also charge-sheet has been submitted, let him be  
released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 5,000/-  
(Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each  
or any other surety as fixed by the Court to the  
satisfaction of Special Judge, Vigilance-II, Patna in  
connection with Special Case No. 54 of 2014 arising out of  
Vigilance P.S. Case No. 53 of 2014 subject to the following

conditions:- (i) That one of the bailors will be a close relative of the Petitioner who will give an affidavit giving genealogy as to how he is related with the Petitioner. The bailor will also undertake to inform the Court if there is any change in the address of the Petitioner. (ii) That the Petitioner will give an undertaking that he will receive the police papers on the given date and be present on date fixed for charge and if he fails to do so on two given dates and delays the trial in any manner, his bail will be liable to be cancelled for reasons of misuse. (iii) That the Petitioner will be well represented on each date and if he fails to do so on two consecutive dates, his bail will be liable to be cancelled.
