Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner  
and the State.

This is a petition for grant of regular bail for  
offence under Sections 396, 307, 436 and 353 of the  
Indian Penal Code, 27 of the Arms Act, 3 and 4 of  
the Explosive Substances Act and 17 of the Criminal  
Law Amendment Act.

It has been submitted on behalf of the  
petitioner that the name of the petitioner in the  
present case has appeared after a period of nine  
years. It has, further, been submitted that there is  
no direct or indirect evidence against the petitioner.  
It has, further, been submitted that other co-  
accused have been granted bail in Cr. Misc. No.  
38805 of 2014 and 48259 of 2014.

It has been pointed out on behalf of the  
State that the petitioner has played active role in the

present case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each in connection with Madhuban P.S.
