languishing in jail custody since long.

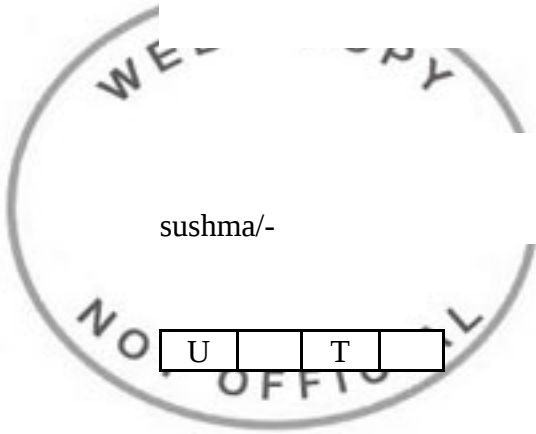
Considering the facts and circumstances of the case as
