2 06-01-2015 The petitioner is languishing in custody since 13.08.2014 in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 395 of the I.P.C.

The accusation is of committing dacoity in the house of the informant. The F.I.R was lodged against unknown. The name of the petitioner sprang up when the stolen mobile was recovered from the possession of the petitioner after two months of the occurrence.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that I.M.E.I number of the robbed mobile and the mobile recovered from the petitioner are different. It is further submitted that neither the petitioner nor the robbed mobile was put on T.I.P.

A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the fact that petitioner was not

put on T.I.P and petitioner has no criminal antecedent, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hilsa, Nalanda in connection with Tharthari P.S. Case No. 47 of 2013.
