It appears from perusal of the first information report as well as several paragraphs of the case diary that husband of the informant was killed by the extremists and in course of investigation, some witnesses expressed their suspicion against the petitioner and except the aforesaid material, there appears to be nothing against him.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as submissions of the parties, let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with

two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sessions Judge, Jamui in connection with Barhat P.S. Case No. 21 of 2013 corresponding to U.A.P. Case No. 20 of 2015.
